  - World Language & Math = must appeal if what you want is different from your teacher’s recommendation

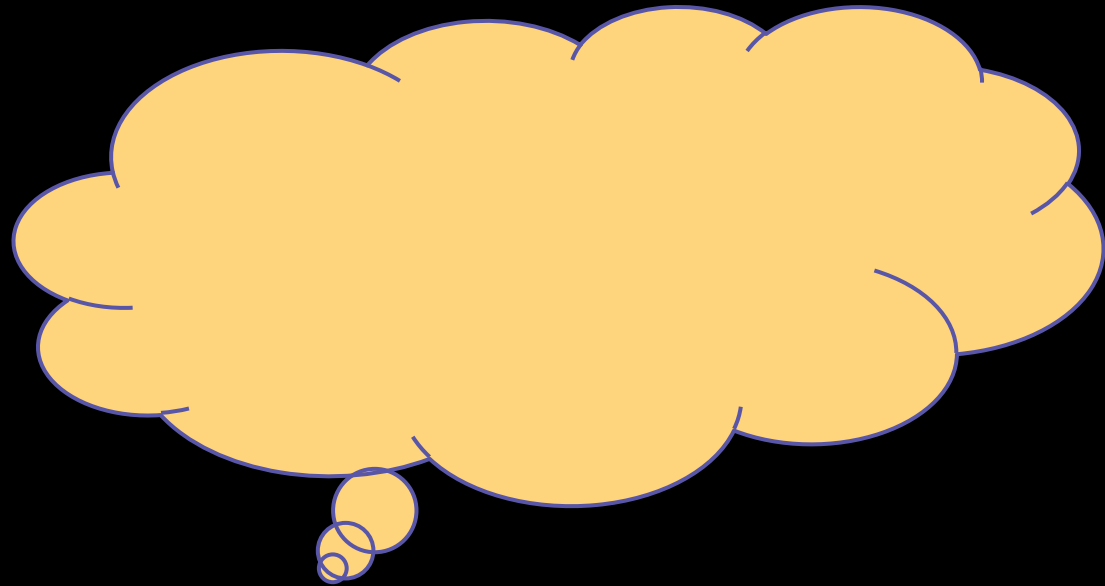
# your REQUESTS
