AFTERNOON INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The Afternoon Instructional Program (AIP) is particularly directed toward a student who can function more effectively in classes that are more tightly structured with limited free time between periods and is in need of career planning and social behavioral guidance. Students interested in this program must be referred by a member of the PPS staff and/or school administrator and must make application to the Director.

The goals of the program are:

- To provide a curriculum that meets all graduation requirements.
- To provide a learning environment that promotes a sense of pride, respect, teamwork and leadership.
- To help students become intrinsically motivated toward their schooling and work.
- To provide specific career planning and career threaded cross disciplinary approaches to instruction.
- To develop academic and authentic skills that enhance the student's ability to compete for post-secondary schooling and for employment in the rapidly changing work place.

The Afternoon Instructional Program offers mandatory credited courses which work to build an overall program "collective team consciousness." These are designated with an (M).
