
ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT

On October 30, 1987 the Federal Government enacted legislation for application through the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), entitled the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This law requires all elementary and secondary schools, both public and private, to conduct inspections to determine the location of asbestos containing materials and subsequently, to develop a management plan to ensure proper maintenance of these materials. This legislation requires, moreover, that students' parents and teachers be apprised of the results of such inspections. This notice is provided to comply with that requirement.

In consultation with HYGENIX, Inc. a state certified contractor, the New Canaan Public Schools has submitted the required asbestos survey reports and management plans, for all of its schools, to the State Department of Public Health. As required the survey reports and management plans will be available for public inspection on file in the main office of each school building, and at the office of the Superintendent during normal school hours.
